- 1) Please make sure that if you plan to attend the Awards Banquet, either check the Banquet Confirmation or Banquet Ticket option on the Agenda page. Banquet tickets are free for Regular (Member and Non-member) Registrants and Student Registrants; all other Registrants must purchase a \$30 ticket to attend the banquet.
- 2) After you've confirmed/purchased your banquet ticket, please be sure to select a meal option on the "Extras" tab.
- 3) If you are renewing dues or becoming a member at the same time as registering, that option is available. However, if you forget, or need to renew on a separate card, please wait until you're at the conference (we can take care of you then, and you can still register as a "member," or renew dues separately. There are transaction and processing fees with each individual registration, so if someone registers online and then comes back and pays for a membership, those fees are charged twice. (This is not unique to the registration service we are using this year.)
- 4) If you want to register a group of people (e.g., Student Chapters), you can do that, but first you must register yourself. Then, at the Travel/Lodging, or at the Checkout page, you can choose an option to add additional people (you will need their e-mail addresses to do so). Keep in mind that the "Extras" tab will tally everyone at once, so make sure the number of people matches with the number of options chosen (i.e., 15 students attending the banquet, the meal option adds up to 15, etc.)
