Professional Development Committee Chair

Conservation Affairs Committee Chair

The Conservation Affairs Committee is part of TWS's Conservation Affairs Network. The role of the Chapter Conservation Affairs Committee is to effectively identify and engage in important local, regional, and national wildlife policy activities that have the potential to impact the California Central Coast area. The Chair is responsible for planning bi-monthly meetings and/or phone conferences with members, and is expected to work closely with the board members to keep committee membership and activity sustainable.

Newsletter Editor

The newsletter editor will manage and oversee the production of a quarterly newsletter (spring, summer, fall, winter) with input from the board members. With the use of new chapter management software, newsletter production will be easier than ever.

Membership Manager

The membership manager, with the help of new chapter management software, will oversee the membership of the California Central Coast Chapter TWS. Duties include: ensuring new members are uploaded into the system, setting up automatic emails for new/renew/overdue members, and sending the chapter board a monthly update on membership numbers.
