Spring Council Meeting Update

- Stephenson reports
- Council really likes our engagement with information we bring to Council meetings and how we are working
- Council is trying to lump additional misc. budget items that are not "necessary" and the idea is that these additional funds will be an endowment
 - We cannot really tap into these, but possible changes may be made
 - Struck a deal that conference registration has only increased \$10 for students and double that for professionals
 - Topic being discussed to figure out what needs to happen to find a happy medium for conference registration
- Dues are being raised \$1
 - Inflation has not been accounted for in the past couple years
- o 2020 conference will be in Louisville, KT
- o 2019 in Reno, NV Joint with AFS
- So far Mexico Conference was brought up but not acted upon
 - Most Council members were in support
- Honors Society was brought up as well
 - Determined that this would not create anything new, and was struck down
- Things to focus on:
 - Push for nominations for awards
 - Push for Give Back Program
 - Get more students sign-up for this
 - What is the cost \$2 per each TWP
 - Table at the conference letting people know about it and allowing people to nominate someone on site
 - Staff is busy want people recruited
 - Push for volunteers
 - Or built in to the registration desk
 - Need to really think about our goals for the newsletter is it worth the extra effort and is it being read
 - We will keep sending it to Council
 - Could send it to advisors to post on bulletin board
 - Increase Canadian presence

• Symposium Submission

- Our symposium was accepted!
- o Ganoe will be in contact with speakers to make sure they submit abstracts
- Because this symposium was a little different than other symposiums (speakers are not presenting articles/research), if there are more than one speaker during a session, they will be listed as a "co-author" by the lead speaker
- Abstracts for sessions are due by May 18th

- There was a little mix up with submissions and they did not have two of our sections listed: Student Chapter of the Year Presentation and the Student Chapter Advisor of the Year presentation.
- Do we know when the awards will be given out? Ganoe can possible write up draft abstracts for both sections and just remain in touch with Tricia Fry to make sure the names get updated when the awards are given
 - Need to enter agreement with Council to get that information to Tricia as soon as it is available so we can get the individual in on our symposium
- For our group talks, it might be best to work on PowerPoints together and share our own presentations with each other to proofread
- o Send abstracts to each other by May 6

Northeast Conclave Update

- Ganoe reports
- o Ganoe attended the NE Conclave in Starksboro, VT from April 13-15
- >150 students were in attendance representing 14 student chapters all the way from WVU – U Maine
- John McDonald attended and talked to students about things going on in headquarters
- Ganoe gave a brief speech about the SDWG (elections coming up, nominations for awards, committees, etc.) and handed out business cards to all attendants
- Students displayed interest in the working group and several wanted to know more
- o Ganoe also gave a brief plug for the NE Section (where she serves as Student Rep)
 - She is vacating the undergraduate position and moving into the graduate student position, and nominations are going to open for new undergraduate student rep in the next month or so
 - Many students have displayed interest in the position
 - This would be a great example of a framework for other sections to take up to gain student representation at the section level and a student liaison between the SDWG and TWS Sections
