Legislation/Government Affairs update – K. Wecker (presented by M. Lininger)

- Recovering America's Wildlife Act (HR4647) did not make it through in last session but the Alliance for Fish & Wildlife (coalition of organizations and industry) will reintroduce the bill again
- The House of Representatives passed omnibus budget bill for Fiscal Year 2019 which contained a 2 million dollar increase for the state and tribal wildlife grants program (\$65.57 million total). The competitive SWG grants program remained stable at 4.2 and 6.6 million dollars, respectively. The bill now goes to Senate where leadership has said they will not advance the spending package until there is agreement by the White House which has said they would veto the bill because of insufficient border security funding.
- K. Wecker offered her resignation as the legislation/government affairs committee chair effective immediately, but will offer assistance in training/locating a replacement person in that capacity
