



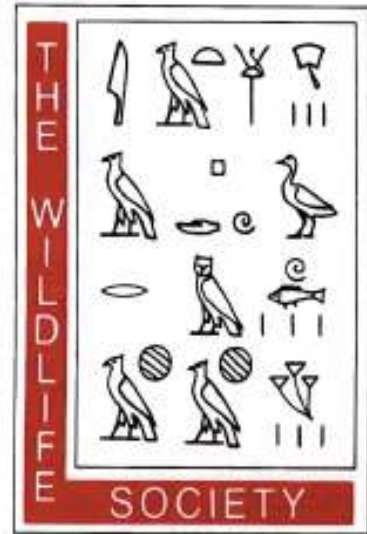

## UWWG Student Scholarship Application Guidelines

The Urban Wildlife Working Group of The Wildlife Society (UWWG) makes funds available to students to encourage their participation in the International Urban Wildlife Conference. These funds can be used for partial reimbursement of transportation, lodging, registration, and meal expenses. Travel grants of up to \$500 will be awarded to selected recipients, and made available contingent upon registering for the conference.

An individual is eligible for consideration if s/he is a current student or recent graduate (within past 3 years).

Applicants must submit a PDF of the following:

1. completed application form signed by student and advisor
2. abstract of talk/poster (if presenting)
3. evidence of abstract acceptance (if presenting)
4. draft or final talk/poster (if presenting)

Application scoring will be based on completeness. **Priority** will be given to students presenting a talk or poster and membership in [The Wildlife Society](#) is preferred but not required. Application and all requested materials should be submitted to Shannon Pederson at [Shannonp@umd.edu](mailto:Shannonp@umd.edu) by **March 1, 2015**. Microsoft Word documents and pdfs are acceptable formats. Grant recipients will be informed of their acceptance/denial around March 15, 2015 via email. At that time, grant recipient needs to provide documentation of conference registration to receive funding.
