To mark the occasion, the Chapter will be hosting a two-night camping trip, **August 5-7th**, at Sierra National Forest's **Trapper Springs Campground**. Trapper Springs Campground sits on the west side of Courtright Reservoir, an approximate 2 hour drive east of Fresno.

The location provides opportunity for a variety of recreation activities including fishing, birding, hiking, kayaking, boating, botanizing rare plants in nearby meadows, or just beating the San Joaquin Valley heat in the sweet High Sierra sunshine!
