### **Purpose:**

### **About the Scholarship/Eligibility:**

- To be eligible, applicants must be a member of WY-TWS at the time of application.\*
- Scholarships are available to both professionals and graduate students.
- Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis and may be allocated quickly.

### **Scholarship Application Components:**

Applicants must electronically submit the following materials:

- Completed application
- Resume or curriculum vitae
