Title: "Research into an emergent elk hoof disease in the Northwest U.S."

<u>Synopsis</u>: Treponeme-associated hoof disease (TAHD) of elk was first identified in Washington, and more recently detected in Oregon, Idaho, and California. Severe lesions include sole ulcers and sloughed hoof capsules that result in debilitation. Join us for information useful to aid with surveillance for hoof disease, as well as to learn about a research program that ranges from metagenomics to human dimensions developed to investigate this emerging disease.

## Presenter:

## Margaret Wild, DVM, PhD, CWB®

Dr. Wild focuses on protecting and promoting the health of wildlife, primarily through the study of emerging infectious diseases. She received her BS in wildlife biology, DVM, and PhD in zoology, all from Colorado State University. After working as a researcher with the Colorado Division of Wildlife, she was the chief wildlife veterinarian for the National Park Service for 18 years. In 2018, she moved to Washington State University where she is currently a professor in the College of Veterinary Medicine focused on studying an emergent hoof disease in elk.
