Call for BWG Student Virtual Travel Grants for the 2022 TWS Annual Conference

Submission Deadline: July 15, 2022

The Biometrics Working Group (BWG) is pleased to announce its annual call for student travel grants. The purpose of the travel grants is to promote and support student interest in biometrics and the BWG. Up to 5 travel grants of at least \$750 are available this year.

Current students (graduate or undergraduate) and recent graduates (individuals that graduated within two years of the scheduled conference) are eligible for the travel grants if they are current members of The Wildlife Society and are presenting papers or posters at the 2022 annual conference. Applicants do not need to be members of the Biometrics Working Group. Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate strong statistical or mathematical skills.

To be considered for a student virtual travel grant, please submit the following material as a single PDF document:

1. Cover letter describing your interests in quantitative wildlife ecology (maximum 1 page)
2. Letter of support from a mentor, advisor, or supervisor
3. Abstract and title of the paper or presentation being presented at the meeting

The deadline for submission of travel grants is **July 15, 2022**. To apply, email Kylee Dunham at kylee583@gmail.com with “BWG Student Virtual Travel Grant” in the subject line. Following submission, you will receive an email confirming receipt of your application. We aim to notify all applicants of our decision within a month of the submission deadline.
