The WDWG travel grant is intended to promote student interest and participation in the working group, and to recognize excellent students in the area of wildlife disease. Applicants must be students and members of The Wildlife Society.

To apply, submit the following :

- **A cover letter** (maximum 1 page) that explains your interest and experience in wildlife health and disease ecology. In the letter, please include the following:
 - please indicate how else your planned conference attendance will be funded and/or if you are presenting at the conference
 - Past or current involvement with TWS or WDWG as a student or professional
- **The name, affiliation, and contact information** for one referee that you interact with as a student (e.g., advisor, professor, lab instructor, etc).

The deadline for submission is **October 15, 2022** . The recipient of the award will be notified by **October 25, 2022** and disbursement of funds will be initiated on **October 26, 2022**. To submit an application, please complete [this google form](#) by 10/15/22 at 11:59pm
