- <u>Student Conservationist Award</u> is presented to an undergraduate or graduate student in a wildliferelated field at a Minnesota college or university who has shown high scholastic achievement, and who shows promise as a future wildlife professional.
- <u>Law Enforcement Award</u> is presented to an individual who has demonstrated dedication and service to the protection of Minnesota's natural resources.
- Excellence in Mentorship Award is a new award in 2022. This award acknowledges contributions to our field through mentorship and guidance.
- North Star Award for Special Achievement in Wildlife Conservation is intended to recognize a singular and exceptional achievement or accomplishment in the last 5 years that advanced wildlife conservation in Minnesota or elsewhere. Nominees must have been MNTWS members in good standing at the time of the achievement.
