


Wildlife Damage Management Working Group The Wildlife Society 2024 Travel Grant Application for the 31st Annual Conference of The Wildlife Society

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION - August 12, 2024



The program is funded on an annual basis upon approval of the expenditure by the board of the WDMWG. The objective of this program is to provide two travel grants up to \$750 each to members of the WDMWG to assist them in offsetting the cost of travel to a professional wildlife damage meeting. It is the intent of the WDMWG that the meeting will be related

to The Wildlife Society such as the Annual Conference, Wildlife Damage Management Conference, or similar meeting. Priority for funding will be given to applicants who are presenting papers or playing a substantial role in the meeting. This fund is not to be used to support travel associated with field research or similar activities. Recipients must be members in good standing at the time of application as certified by the Treasurer of the Wildlife Damage Management Working Group.
