The selected awardee is expected to contribute to ISWG efforts during the conference, such as helping onsite at the working group booth during the conference, contributing social media or newsletter items, helping with the ISWG symposium, or helping with the in-person working group meeting.

All applicants must be current members of The Wildlife Society and the ISWG, be a current graduate student at either level, and must be conducting research pertaining to invasive species ecology or management. The selected awardee is expected to contribute to ISWG efforts during the conference, such as helping onsite at the working group booth during the conference, contributing social media or newsletter items, helping with the ISWG symposium, or helping with the in-person working group meeting.

Applications are due **Sunday, August 16, 2026**, before 11:59 pm Central Time.
